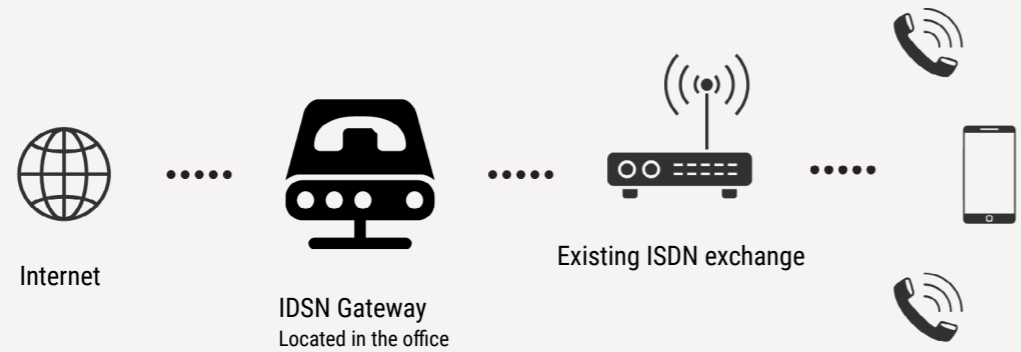


ISDN-to-(S)IP Gateway

BT is phasing out ISDN before the shut-off in 2025.

Our ISDN2(S)IP solutions offer enterprise business and public sector organisations the opportunity to keep their existing on-premise solutions but make and receive calls via the internet leading to large costs savings on new hardware and call charges.



Future-proof your existing hardware and reduce both your fixed-line and variable costs.

Today, business telephone exchanges are usually connected either with ISDN duo (BRI) or ISDN multi (PRI). We have developed a replacement ISDN gateway - ISDN duo / multi and connects the exchange directly via an existing gateway on a fixed-line network.

This gateway converts SIP to ISDN and allows you to continue to use your existing PBX, which results in greatly reduced costs. You do not need to invest further in hardware to achieve compatibility using our equipment.

The solution is essentially 'plug-and-play'. We code the converter box then all a technician on-site does is plug the box into the existing exchange and the broadband connection. When the time is right, the solution can be upgraded to a fully hosted solution.
